Description:

Our Nicaragua mission trip immerses participants in the Nicaraguan culture for a deeper look into the lives of amazing people. During your trip, you'll connect with local families, build lifelong friendships, and help to bring clean water and sanitary conditions to members of the community you serve.

Typical Mission Trip Week

Day 1: Saturday

- 4:00am – Arrive @ Omaha Eppley Airport
- 6:15am – Flight Leaves Omaha
- 12:06pm - Arrive in Managua, Nicaragua, and travel to Chinandega (3) hours.

Day 2: Sunday

- Opportunity to attend local church service and visit a local community, or climb the Cerro Negro volcano.

Day 3: Monday

- Community work – Dig Water System or Build Bathrooms

Day 4: Tuesday

- Community work – Dig Water System or Build Bathrooms

Day 5: Wednesday

- Community work – Visit Amigos Academy School
- Activity – Explore Chinandega / Visit Amigos Baseball Academy
- Dinner in Town

Day 6: Thursday

- Community work – Agro Amigos (Farm Day)

Day 7: Friday

- Community work – Water System or Bathrooms Celebration

Day 8: Saturday

- 7:00am - Depart from Chinandega to the airport in Managua
- 1:20pm – Flight Leaves Managua
- 10:30pm – Arrive Home

Round Trip Airline Transportation from Eppley Airport in Omaha, NE to Managua, Nicaragua.

Amigos for Christ Mission Trip

All in-country transportation, most meals from Saturday Night-Saturday Morning, lodging, emergency medical insurance, and a t-shirt. Bedding, Pillows, towels, and purified water are also provided.

Additional Out of Pocket Costs and Fees

Baggage Fees

\$90 checked bags (\$40 from Omaha, \$50 from Managua)

Travel Meals

\$10-\$15 each – 4 Meals (Breakfast & Lunch on the Way There - Lunch & Dinner on the Way Back)

Midweek Lunch

\$15-\$20 – Opportunity to Eat Lunch While Exploring Town

Nicaragua Tourist Fee

\$10 cash only - Nicaraguan Tourist Entrance Fee (Paid at airport upon arrival)

Souvenirs, Snacks, etc

\$30-\$100 – This is up to you how much you bring. Credit Cards are accepted most places.

Passport fees - \$130-\$160

Shots and Immunizations

Cash or Credit Cards?

Credit Cards are often easier to use at the airports, grocery store, convenience stores, and restaurants. Cash may be preferred at local/street vendors. If your Credit Card provider or bank charges fees for international usage, you can just bring cash. You will not need to exchange American Dollars for Nicaraguan Cordobas during the trip. Almost all places accept US Currency. Make sure you bring small bills as they are not able to make change and you don't want to have a ton of Nicaraguan money left over.
